Consolidate Ida B. Wells Academy

Recommendation to be effective for the 2026-27 school year

Recommendation

The recommendation is to consolidate Ida B. Wells Academy. Students may continue to exercise their choice transfer option at any district school with available seats. Students may also attend their zoned schools. Any alternative education students at Ida B. Wells Academy will attend Norris Achievement Academy.

Rationale for Consolidation

The Ida B. Wells facility has ten-year maintenance costs of \$5.8 million. On the twentieth day, there were only 84 students enrolled across the school's nine grades (K-8), yielding a 16% utilization. The students will be better served in schools with more students, staff, and programming.

Ida B. Wells has no attendance zone; students attend the school by choice. Students currently at the school are from 18 different school attendance zones.

Each school's performance profile includes the most recent unembargoed district, state, and federal accountability metrics. Together, these metrics provide an overview of student outcomes at each school.

Tennessee's school letter grading system provides a snapshot of how each school performed based on student achievement, growth, and college & career readiness. In 23-24, Ida B. Wells earned a B. The School Performance Scorecard (SPS) uses the following performance categories and levels: *Needs Improvement* (1 - 1.99), *Fair* (2 - 2.99), *Good* (3 - 3.99), and *Excellent* (4 - 5). In 24-25, Ida B. Wells' overall level of 4.2 placed them in the *Excellent* category.

Students who score "Met" or "Exceeded" on TCAP assessments are considered proficient. In 24-25, Ida B. Well's had an ELA proficient rate of 25% and a math proficiency rate of 27.6%. The Tennessee Value-Added Assessment System (TVAAS) measures student growth from one school year to the next. Level 5 is the highest score possible, and Level 1 is the lowest score possible. Level 3 represents average growth. In 24-25, Ida B. Wells earned the highest growth score possible.

Chronic absenteeism is defined as a student who is absent for 10 percent or more of the instructional days for which he or she is enrolled in a school (must be enrolled for at least 50% of the instructional days). In 23-24, Ida B. Well's chronic absenteeism rate was 22.7%.

Ida B. Wells Academy has experienced declining enrollment for the past four years. The average enrollment for the past five years is 107. However, this average is positively impacted by an enrollment of 150 in 22-23 which is 67 students higher than the current enrollment.

Facilities Profile

Ida B. Wells Academy is 62 years old. The building is 71,059 square feet on 3.4 acres of land. The five-year facility condition index (FCI) is 16% with ten-year maintenance costs of \$5.8 million. There were only 84 students enrolled in the school at twentieth day, yielding a 16% utilization.


